The Orders are drawn in sterling, the commission chargeable being for £2 and under, 25 cents: from £2 to £5, 50 cts.; from £5 to £7, 75 cts.; from £7 to £10, \$1.00. No order can be drawn for more than £10; but any number of orders for £10 each may be procured.
