The Gloucester Consistory Court has granted a faculty to the Rev. H. R. Hanson, Rector of Cranham, to place on the chancel-screen in the Parish Church a cross bearing a figure of Christ, and flanked by figures of the Virgin Mary and St. John-the-Apostle. A bronze tablet will be inscribed:—"To the greater glory of God and in pious memory of King Edward VII., this holy rood, the offering of the people of Cranham, was dedicated in the Coronation year of King George V., A.D. 1911."
