### Synapsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations.

THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available to maintain a manitohe, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear or sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (out not Sub-Agency,) on certain conditions.

Lands Agency (set not Sub-Agency,) on certain conditions.

Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within aine miles of his homestead on a farm of it least 80 acrose, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicality. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section adongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Six, m-saths residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 50 across extra cultivation. Pro-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.
