## Synopsis of Canadian Land Regulations

THE sole head of male over 18 years of age must have a quarter section of Dominion land in Manitoba or Alberta. Application in person at the Dominion or sub-Agency for the Dominion proxy may be made on certain conditions.

Duties—Six months residence of the land years. A homesteaded nine miles of his home at least 80 acres, on a habitable house is required residence is performed in certain districts a good standing may be section alongside his \$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Six months of three years after patent; also 50 acres Free-emption patent may be as homesteaded conditions.

A settler who has extended right may take extended in certain districts acre. Duties—Must be out of three years, cultivation a house worth \$300.
