How the Chinese are wasting British capital in building the Shanghai-Hankow-Ningpo railway is told by the Pekin correspondent of the London Times, who says: "The railway presents every possible defect. Bridges are unsafe. Rails are of native manufacture, of obsolete section, spiked into soft wood sleepers from Manchuria and Japan. Sleepers are wrongly laid. Wrongly laid and shoddy rails are little more than one year's work. Different patterns of rolling stock are in use. Where there was difficulty in bridging a stream the Chinese built the bridge on dry land and then dug a canal and diverted the waterway under the bridge."
