And all or any of the above packages described as capable of holding liquids, when containing goods exempt from duty under this Act, shall be charged with duty of twenty per centum ad valorem. But all packages not hereinbefore specified, and not specially charged with duty by any unrepealed enactment; and being the usual and ordinary packages in which goods are packed for exportation only, according to the general usage and custom of trade, shall be free of duty.
