FISHING FOR GERMAN SUBMARINES.

London, March 4.—At harbor entrances and at other strategic points around the British Isles, the Admiralty has set miles of submarine traps to catch German underwater craft engaged in blockading England. Report has it that three submarines were caught during the first ten days of the blockade, but confirmation is lacking. The traps set for submarines are not unlike gill nets used by fishermen. Malleable iron frames ten feet square, three frames joined are sunk to a depth of thirty feet, suspended from immense buoys. The submarine is a blind thing under water, steering by chart and compass. Entering one of these frames, its sides are caught and causing the lower frame to buckle upward, catching the propeller. Thus held the craft is in the position of a fish floundering in a net, and its occupants are doomed. From time to time British sailors visit the buoys and inspect the frames, such as a fisherman would look after his set lines.

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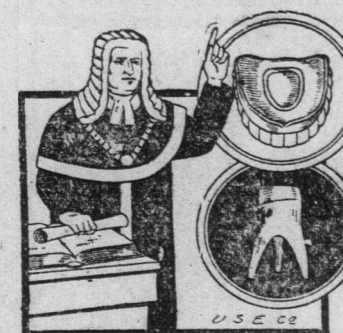
