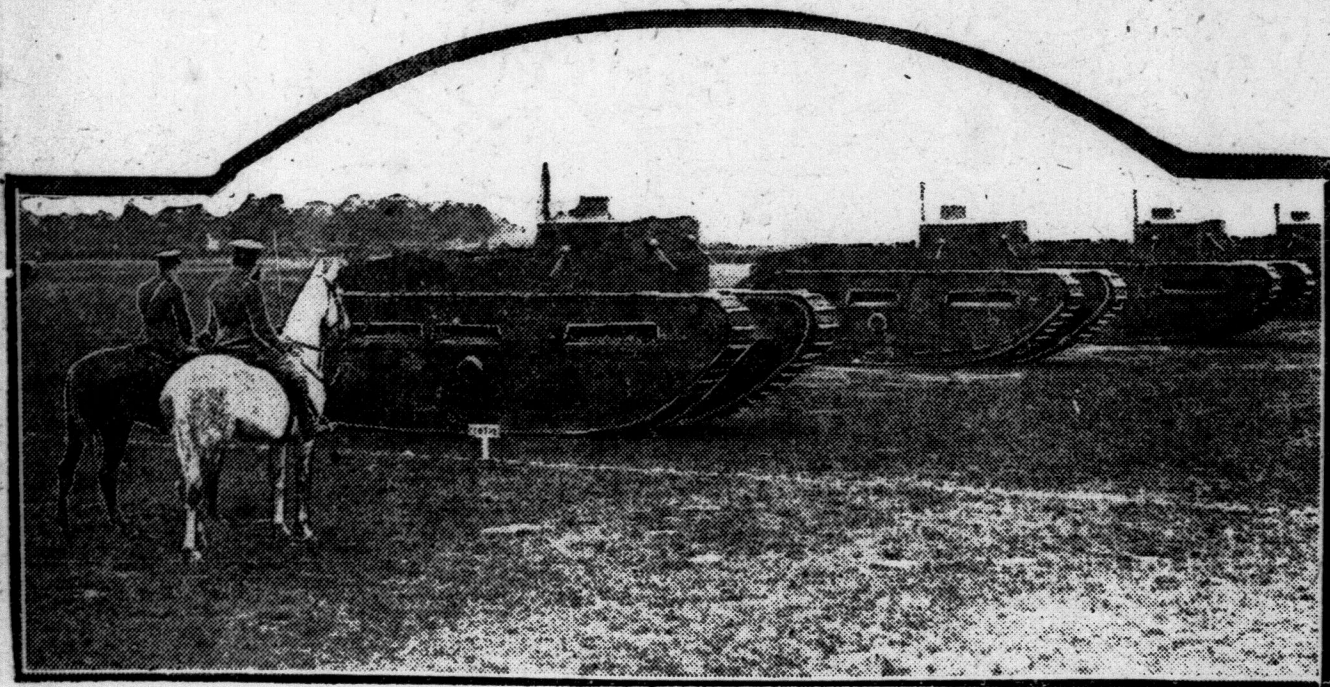


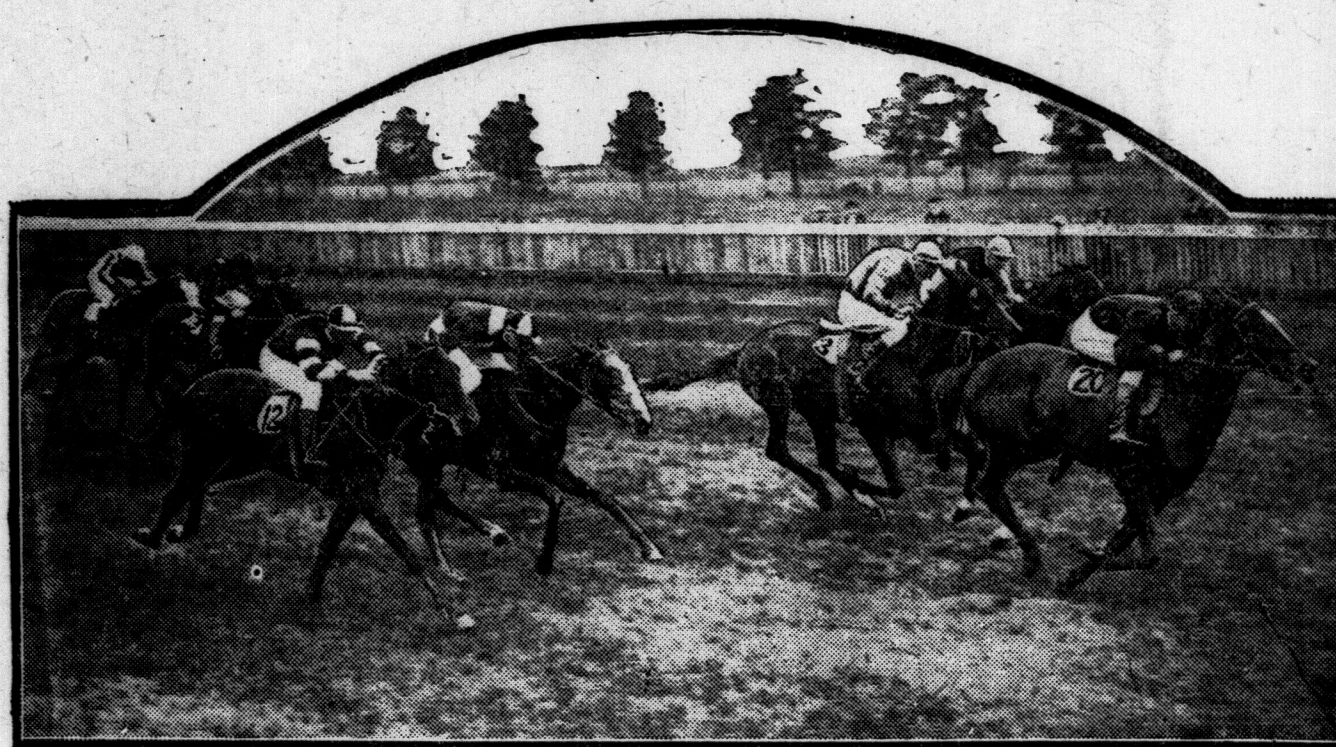

A splendid action photograph of a recent Old Country race at Gatwick. Number twenty finished first.



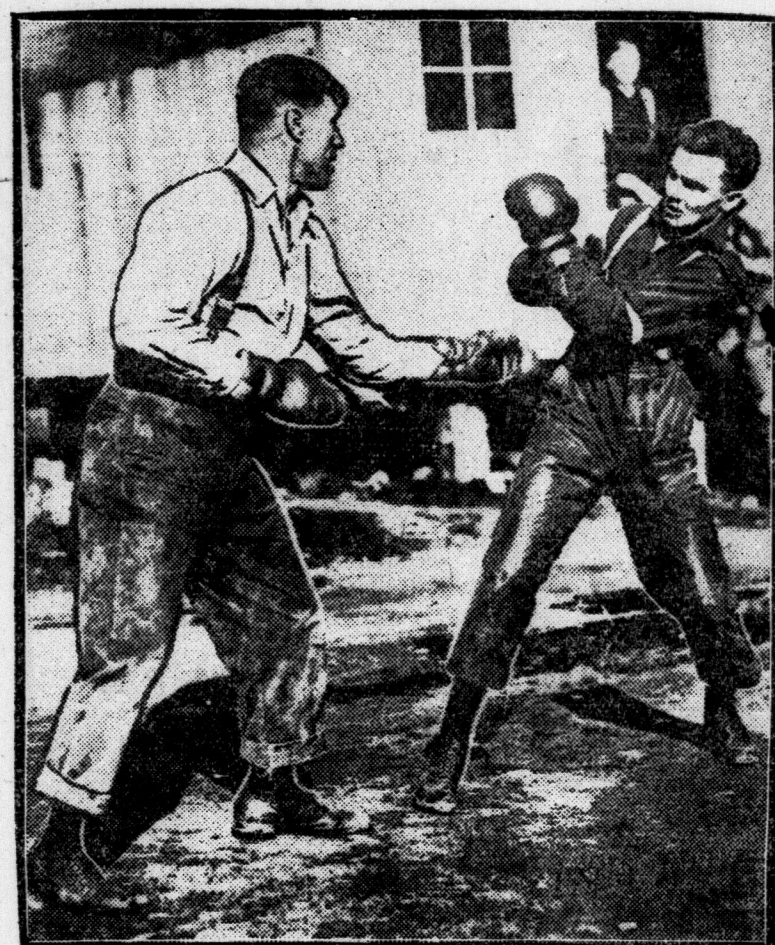
Laphne Pollard and her infant son, listening-in to a radio concert in her dressing room at a London theatre.

Richmond W. Landon, who formerly jumped for Yale at the recent Olympics, clearing the bar at six feet, three inches, from scratch.



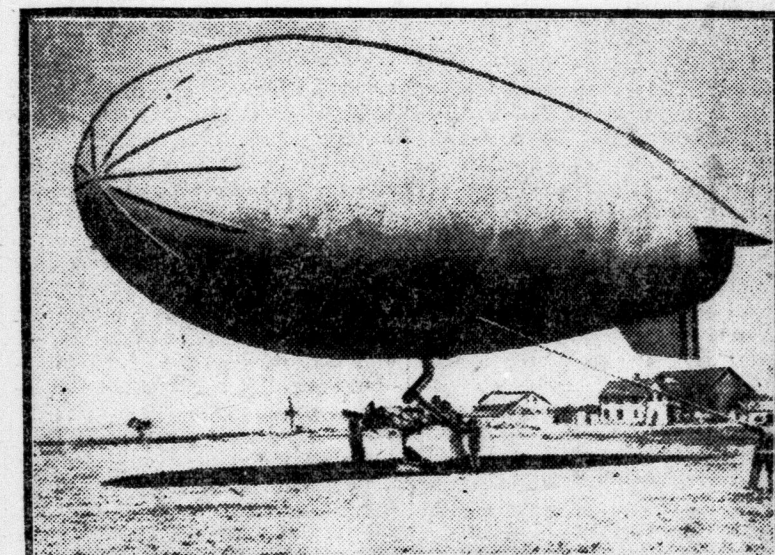
The Belgian army has recently installed new sentry boxes in the Ruhr district. An extension apparatus offers protection from rain.



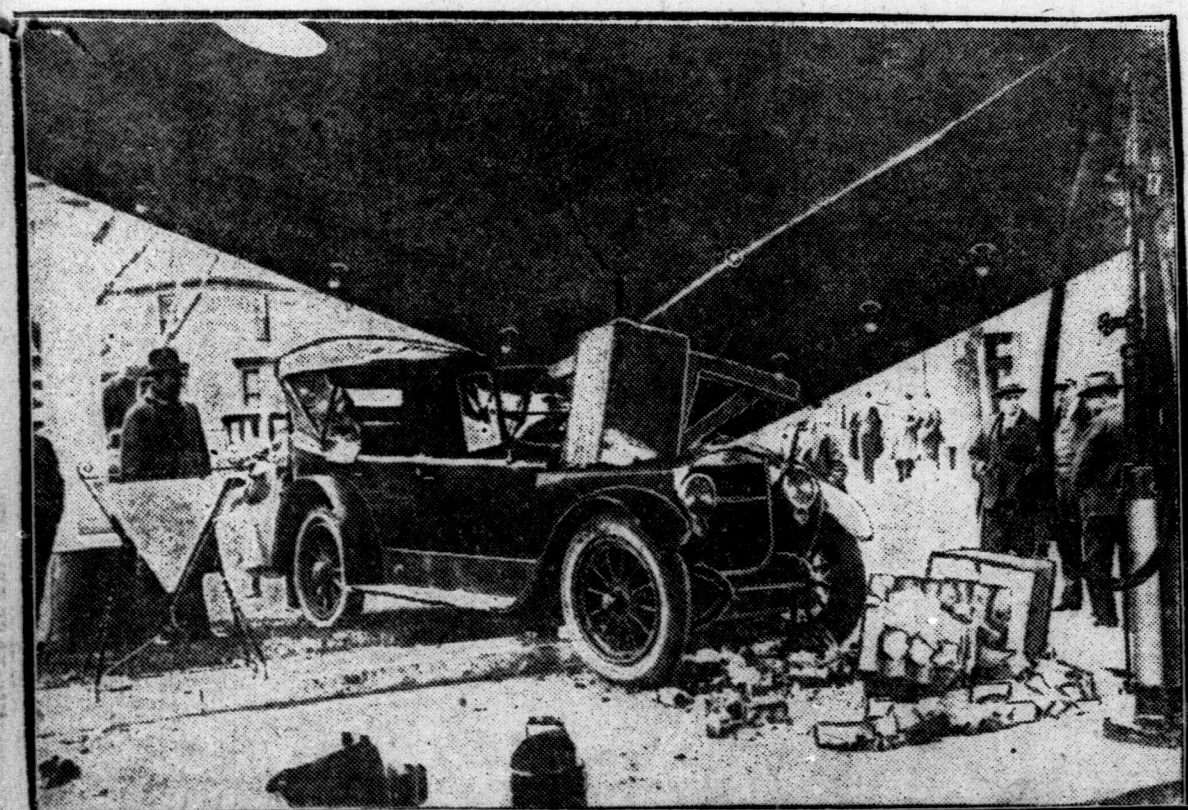
Dorothy Watson, a telephone operator, was proclaimed the most beautiful girl in St. Paul, Minn., recently.



Ivor Novella, composer and screen star, is returning to England for a six weeks' stay.



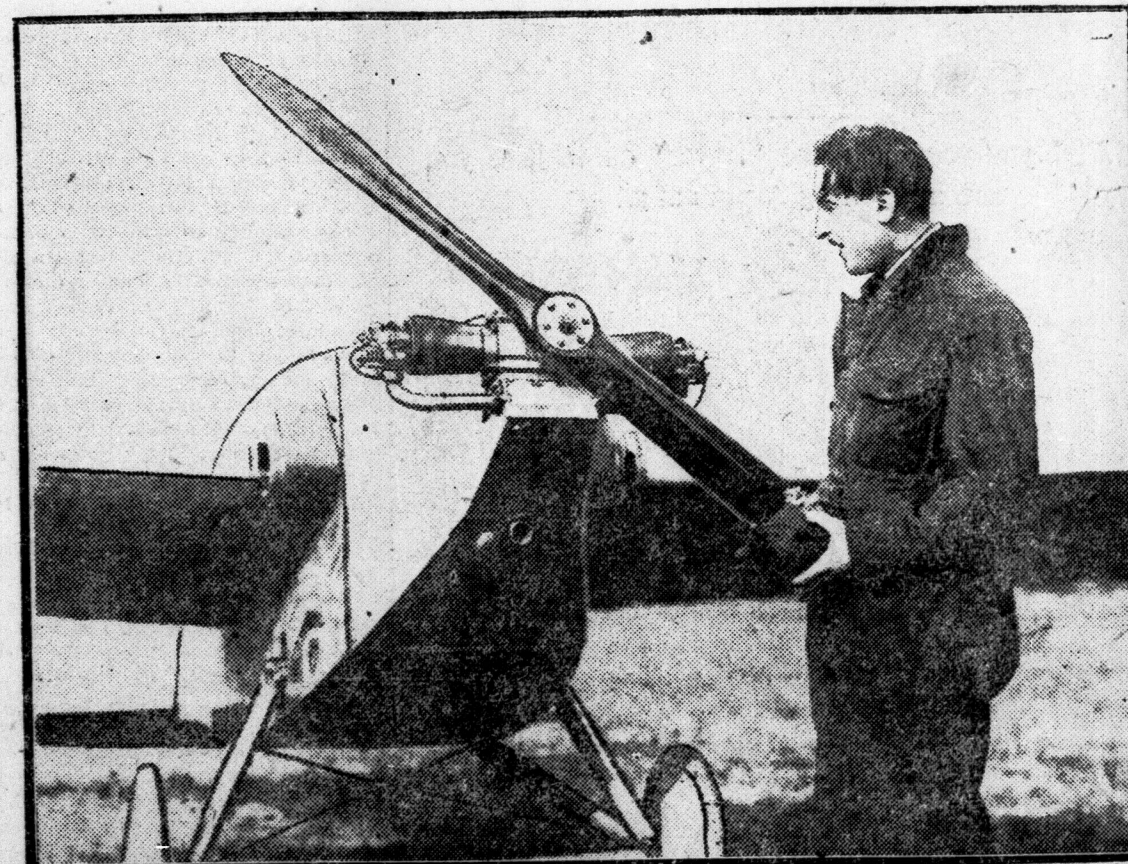
This balloon of the United States army expects to wipe out the crop pests this year. The special apparatus for spraying insecticide may be seen.
