

AVANA ELECTRIC IS STILL SOARING

Resumes Upward March On Wall Street—Silk Stocks Strong.

Associated Press Despatch. New York, June 15.—Operators on the big side found fresh encouragement in the fact that the renewal rate for call money remained unchanged at 3 1/2 per cent, despite today's demands, which are widely construed as further proof of the lack of any strain in the credit situation. New leaders were brought forward when the old favorites showed signs of halting on profit-taking, which shares being run up briskly on reports of heavy spring sales of silk fabrics. Special points of strength also popped out in the public utilities. Havana Electric resumed its upward movement by climbing 4 1/2 points before noon. Electric Power moving up two points for the second time in the week. Common was offered freely on rumors of an early offering of stock, but the market preferred a new peak price for the year as did Kelly-Springfield, and eight per cent, Remington-Prouty, Freeport-Texas and United prior first preferred.

BARCELONA DROPS BUTCHER COWS ON TORONTO MART GO TO DEMAND

Falls To 21 3/4, But Recovers Slightly—Atlantic Sugar Advances.
