Gentlemen:—
Your Finance Committee beg leave to report as follows:—We have examined all bills and accounts placed in our hands for 1918 and recommend those attached for payment.

We find the estimated expenditure over probable receipts to be \$33,654.48 and recommend that this sum be assessed and collected from the rate-payers of the County, the rate therefore being 75 cents on the \$100 of Assessed.
