



If the tender he not accepted, the cheque will be returned, and if a contract be entered into for a part only of the supplies tendered for, an accepted cheque for five per cent. of the amount of the contract may be substituted for that which accompanied the tender, the contract security cheque will be retained by the Department until the end of the fiscal year.

Each tender must, in addition to the signature of the tenderrable signed by two sureties accepts.
