Banana Cake:—One of the novelties and luxuries of the period is banana cake. Take one cup of butter, two cups of sugar, one cup of water or of sweet milk, three eggs, four cups of flour, two small teappoonsful of baking powder. Mix lightly and bake in layers. Make an icing of the whites of two eggs, and one cup and a half of powdered sugar. Spread this on the layers, and then cover thickly and entirely with bananas sliced fine. The cake may be flavoured with vanilla. The torreshould may be flavoured with vanilla. The top should be simply frosted.

Ariota Jelly.—Tapioca jelly is really delicious. Soak half a cupful of tapioca in two cupfuls of water for four hours. Sweeten to taste and place the vessel in another containing boiling water. Let it cook about an hour, stirring frequently. It should be quite clear. Add the juice of half a lemon and a little of the grated skin. Pour into little moulds, and serve, when cold, with cream sweetened and flavoured.

STUFFED EGGS.—Cut six boiled eggs in two. Take out the yolks and mash them fine. Add two tablespoonfuls of butter, one of cream, two or three drops of onion juice, and salt and pepper to taste. Mix all thoroughly. Fill the eggs from the mixture, and put them together. There will be a little filling left, to which add a well beaten egg. Cover the eggs with this last preparation, and roll in cracker crumbs. Fry in boiling lard until a light brown.

LIFTING FURNITURE. - Many housekeep ers dread the labour of lifting heavy furni-ture during house-cleaning. The carpet must be removed, cleaned and replaced, and a heavy bookcase or case of drawers, is not heavy bookease or ease of drawers, is not easily raised from the floor, and many a lame tack is the result. All this hard work is entirely unnecessary. Procure a stout wooden lever, four or five feet long, or longer, and about double the size of a common crow-bar, and placing the stout end under the heavy furniture, raise gradually a fourth or half an inch, for withdrawing or replacing the carpet. Articles weighing several hundred pounds, heavy stoves, etc., may be thus raised with the exertion of a little strength, or with one hand. one hand.
