SCHOOLS AT COCHIN.

By the kindness of Mr. Laseron, our missionary at Cochin we are able to present our readers with the above sketch of a school-house there, to which he refers in the following terms:—

"I have much pleasure in sending you a sketch. The build, ing on the left hand is the boys' present school-room; it is only a temporary building, covered with leaves, which require to be renewed every year; it stands too low, and, consequently is very hot. We require a new boys' school-house; and I sincerely trust that the members of the Juvenile Association will aid us in erecting a substantial building. The house on the right presents a portion of the front of the mission house; it stands on a part of the old rampart of Cochin. We have had, very lately, news from Cochin; the work there is steadily progressing."—Church of Scotland Juvenile Record.
