(4) Distribution of departmental publications. There is a substantial circulation in Canada of publications produced in the Department or reprinted from other sources. In addition to direct mailing, the Department works in close co-operation with non-governmental organizations specifically interested in Canada's external relations, such as the Canadian Institute of International Affairs, the Canadian Atlantic Co-ordinating Committee and the United Nations Association in Canada; some material provided by the Department is distributed by these organizations. Easic material distributed in Canada includes:

> <u>Statements & Speeches</u> on foreign policy. During 1965 thirty statements were distributed and amounted to 2100 English and 600 French copies.

<u>Reference Papers</u> on aspects of Canada's foreign relations, with 1400 English and 500 French copies of 11 different papers.

<u>OECD "Activities"</u> involving monthly distribution of 400 English and 130 French copies.

<u>NATO Letter</u> with a monthly distribution of 2130 English and 700 French copies.
