

1.3.6 Breakdown of employees by occupational stream

Table 3 illustrates the breakdown of Canada-based staff by employment category, occupational group, and occupational stream. Occupational stream is used mostly to clarify the nature of the work performed by rotational employees.

- Most non-rotational employees (2,298 or 91.3%) do not have a specific occupational stream and belong to the non-rotational occupational stream. However, employees belonging to the non-rotational category are found in all occupational groups.
- Rotational employees are more numerous (672 or 33%) in the Political/Economic stream. There are also similar percentages of rotational employees in the rotational Administrative (500 or 24.5%) and Trade (468 or 23%) streams.
- The Management/Consular Services stream accounts for 291 employees (6.4% of the workforce). Of these, 284 are rotational (97.6%).
