

Quite a number of current projects and pilot projects are planned for the 1992-93 fiscal year. I cannot provide you with all the details of these projects here, but I would like to give you their highlights.

1. As part of its Program for the Integration of Persons with a Disability, the government provides direction and financial support in order to promote the integration of athletes with a disability at all levels of competition, as well as the integration of the administration of sports for these athletes by organizations that traditionally look after athletes without disabilities.
2. The purpose of the Science and Medical Support Centres project is to design, using present facilities and expertise, an integrated approach to delivering scientific and medical services that meet the needs of Canadian high-calibre athletes.
3. The Core Funding Program pilot project emphasizes reducing the administrative burden in the accounting relationships between the federal government and national sports organizations.
