1956, as recorded in *Hansard* of that date and also as recorded in the *Journals* of that date.

It has been said that the house does not know what the committee is doing, but no one can deny that the committee knows what it is doing. This committee knows that on March 15 of this year we considered a resolution and reported progress on the same, that resolution being similar to the one which the Minister of Trade and Commerce is now asking this committee to endorse.

It has been said that after having proceeded with order No. 16 we could not then go back and consider order No. 12, so I submit by the same token that since we have considered order No. 12, since it is already along the way, we cannot now consider order No. 16. I need not make the point that I could speak at length on this, for I believe that is all I need to say. I ask Your Honour's ruling as to whether or not it is in order to proceed with this resolution at this time.

The Chairman: These are points which have been discussed at considerable length in the last few days. May I point out to the hon. member for Winnipeg North Centre that there are substantial differences in the resolutions to which he is referring. May I also point out to him that we are in committee of the whole constituted today for the particular purpose of considering this resolution. We have gone into committee of the whole for that purpose. This committee has nothing to do with a resolution of another kind. Therefore I cannot find in favour of the hon. gentleman's point of order.

Mr. Knowles: Mr. Chairman, I appeal your ruling to the house.

Mr. Speaker resumed the chair, and the chairman of the committee made the following report:

When the committee of the whole was considering a resolution respecting Northern Ontario Pipe Line Crown Corporation, Mr. Knowles raised a point of order that the committee could not proceed with the consideration of the resolution since there was under consideration a similar resolution. I ruled that the committee of the whole was constituted to consider a specific proposition and had no knowledge of any other proceedings. Whereupon Mr. Knowles appealed to the house from the ruling of the chair.

Mr. Speaker put the question as follows:

In the committee of the whole, when it was considering a resolution with respect to the Northern Ontario Pipe Line Crown Corporation, Mr. Knowles raised the point of order that the committee could not proceed with the consideration of the resolution since there was under consideration a similar resolution.

Northern Ontario Pipe Line Corporation

The chairman ruled that the committee of the whole was constituted to consider a specific proposition and had no knowledge of any other proceedings. Whereupon Mr. Knowles appealed to the house from the ruling of the chairman.

The house divided on the question: Shall the ruling of the chairman be confirmed? And the ruling was confirmed on the following division:
