The most pressing issues are housing, education, health care

and employment assistance. In these areas, jurisdiction is

fragmented among federal, provincial and municipal Govern-

ments and financial requirements are increasing. It is recog-

nized that better co-ordination is required among the three

levels of Government to eliminate duplication of services,

thereby maximizing the benefits from the existing resources.

In addition, programs should be structured to be complemen-

tary and to address the basic problems rather than merely
