

form what shall be known as the Library of the Alumni. He shall prepare a written report of all such literary works to be read at the annual meeting of the Association.

IV. The Necrologist shall, as far as possible, keep a record of all deaths that occur among the Alumni or students and prepare a brief memoir of the life of each. This report shall be printed from time to time and filed with the papers of the Association.

V. The Executive Committee shall meet at the call of the President or any three of its members, after at least one week's notice, to devise methods to promote the work of the Association, and shall submit a programme of entertainment at the annual meeting.

VI. Every member of the Association shall contribute one dollar annually to the treasury, and no member whose dues are unpaid shall have the right of voting at either an annual or special meeting of the Association.

VII. Alterations or additions may be made to these by-laws at any meeting called in the manner prescribed in the constitution by a majority vote of the members present.
