**Livery Stable Tariffs.**

For a saddle horse by the day of ten hours, \$3; half day, \$2; by the  
hour, for the hour \$1, each subsequent hour 50c.

For single rigs by the day of ten hours, \$4; for half day, \$2.50; by  
the hour, for first hour \$1, each subsequent hour 75c.

For double rigs, by the day of ten hours, \$7; for half day, \$4; by  
the hour, for first hour \$2, each subsequent hour \$1.

Provided that should a driver be required for any of the foregoing  
rigs, an additional sum of \$2 per day of ten hours may be charged for  
such driver, and pro rata for any less time than ten hours.
