

VI. No person can be eligible to be chosen as a member who is under the age of twenty-one years, unless a graduate of a University. Persons not under the age of fifteen shall be admitted as junior members, on being proposed and balloted for, as provided for in Clause 8 of these by-laws, and having complied with the forms required by Section III.

The contribution of junior members shall be 12s. 6d.; such members to receive the *Canadian Journal*, or other authorized medium of publishing the Transactions of the Institute; and they shall be entitled to all the privileges of full members, except those of bearing offices by appointment of the Institute, of sitting in committee, and of voting.
