

ANNUAL MEETING.

The 62nd Annual Meeting of the Grande Ligne Mission was held on the 13th October, 1898, at 2.30 p.m., in the French Baptist Church (l'Oratoire), in the City of Montreal.

Rev. Dr. Dadson, the President, in the chair.

The meeting was opened with singing and prayer.

The minutes of the last Annual Meeting were read and adopted.

The Secretary then presented the Annual Report, the largest part of which was in print for the convenience of those present. The Reports of the different fields were then read, with suggestions as to changes or additional facts, the Missionaries being there to give explanations. The report was adopted and referred to a committee for additional items and publication.

The Treasurer presented the Financial Statement, also the Report of Endowment and Building Fund, both of which were adopted and ordered to be printed with the report.
