BERLIN, March 10—Eugen Richter, radical leader in the Reichstag since its foundation, Bismarck's old opponent, and a long time editor of the Freisinning Zeitung, died at 4 o'clock this morning. Near the close of 1904 Richter suddenly retired from the Freisinninge Zeitung, which he founded, and at the same time ceased to appear at the Reichstag. He was then in feeble health and threatened with the loss of his eye sight.
