9. The Council may from time to time, make such By-Laws for their proper guidance as they may deem necessary, but no by-law to be altered or new one proposed, without at least such notice being given to each member of the Council, as by the by-laws may be determined.

10. The annual prize meeting shall be held at such time and place, as may be agreed on at the annual business meeting.

11. The annual business meeting shall be held at such time

and place as may be determined on, by the by-laws.

12. An Annual report shall be made by the Secretary and Treasurer and submitted to the Council, previous to publica-

12. At the Annual Meeting, the Council shall appoint an Executive Committee, to carry out the Annual Prize Meeting, under such regulations as may be made by the Council from time to time.

BY-LAWS.

1. That the Annual Meeting of the Association be held at

Montreal on the first Thursday in May.

2. Extraordinary meetings may be called by the Secretary, when required by any six members of the Council; fifteen days notice of such meeting given to each member of the Council, and the requisition must state the object for which the meeting is called.

3. Three Auditors shall be appointed annually, whose duties shall be to examine the Treasurer's accounts previous to the

Annual Meeting.

4. The Treasurer shall be required to deposit from time to time-all sums of money paid over to him, on behalf of the Association—in a safe bank.

5. The payment of sums for current expenses, must be authorized by the President, or in his absence, one of the Vice-Presidents. Other payments, to be made only upon the authority of the Council.
