Moves to Serve 25 Year Sentence Before Paying Death Penalty

Likely Months Before Final Decision on Appeal is Reached

HARTFORD, Conn., Nov. 17.—Gerard Chapman will not be hanged on December 3. He must be reprieved again by Governor Trumbull in order that a decision may be reached as to whether he is to serve out in Atlanta the remainder of a sentence of 25 years before he is called on to pay the death penalty for the slaying of a New Britain policeman.
