### PROVIDE FOR SUPERANNUATION

High tribute has been paid to Herbert E. Wardrop by the members of the city council, yesterday, when steps were taken to make provision for the payment of a pension to Mr. Wardrop on the occasion of his retirement.

The matter was brought up in regular session by Mr. Frink, who said that the duties of the office of common clerk had never been performed with greater efficiency than at the present time. He then made a motion, seconded by Mr. Bullock, that as the common clerk had been in the city service for forty-four years and no legal provision had been made for the superannuation of city servants, legisla-

tion should be obtained to make financial provision for Mr. Wardrop upon his resignation or retirement from office, and that a bill for such legislation should be submitted to the government at its next session. The motion was carried unanimously. Mr. Wardrop served thirteen years as deputy clerk and thirty-one years as common clerk. He has served under fifteen mayors and has seen many changes in the method of government in the city. Mr. Wardrop said yesterday that he had no intention to retire for many years yet.
