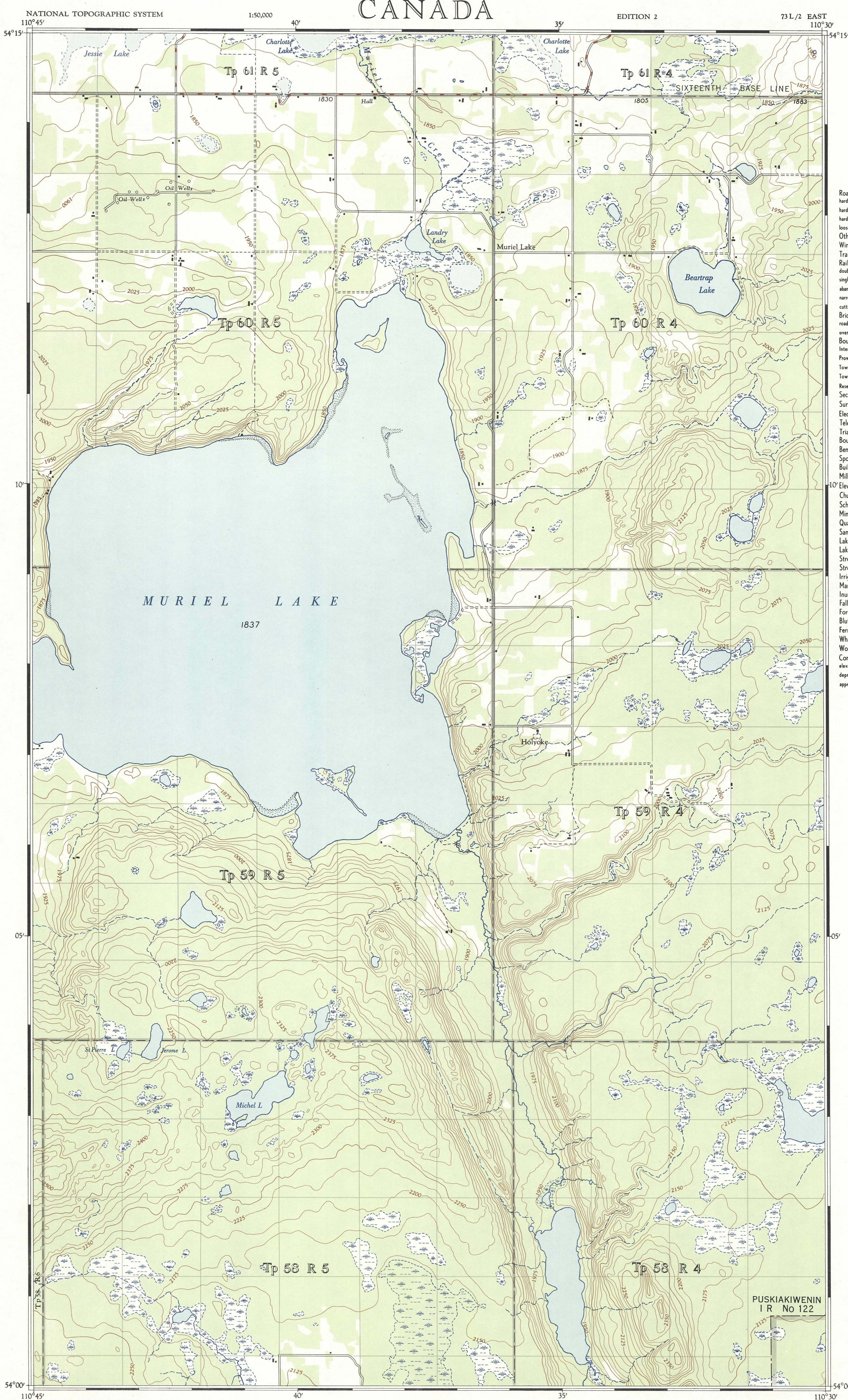

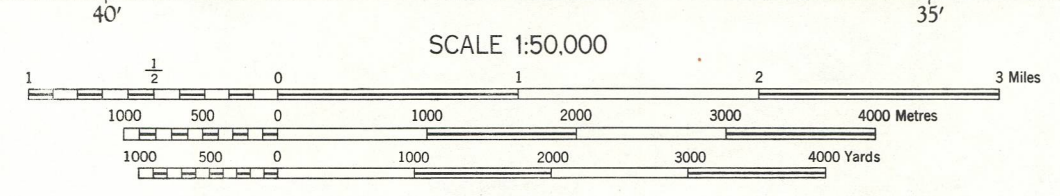
MAGNETIC DECLINATION 23° 21' EAST,
