MARITIME HARNESS CIRCUIT COMPLETES ORGANIZATION

All the Principal Tracks in the Maritime Provinces Have Entered and Good Racing Should Result.

Special to The Standard. Fredericton, N. B., May 12.—The Maritime Harness Racing Circuit for 1911 has been organized and upwards of \$25,000 in purses and stakes will be hung out. The circuit will open at St. John on July 1st and the following towns will come in order: St. Stephen, Woodstock, Fredericton, Chatham, Moncton, two weeks in Cape Breton, then New Glasgow, and then the fall. The fall will probably follow with a fall meeting the last week in September.

Every track has formally expressed a willingness to enter the circuit except Chatham, and a formal answer from there is expected in a day or two.

The preliminary notices for the circuit will be sent out to horsemen at once and entry blanks will quickly follow from the first tracks in the circuit.

The Fredericton Park Association have taken the initiative in the organization of the circuit and the local directors met tonight and adjourned until Monday night when the programmes for the July and September races here will be announced.

Every indication points to a large number of horses from the New Brunswick States, Montreal and elsewhere, the latest trainer to make inquiries being Wm. Hodson, Jr., who is at Dover, N. H., with a stable of horses owned by L. J. Tarte, the Montreal newspaper proprietor.

This stable is headed by Jerrie W., the well known free for all campaigner.
