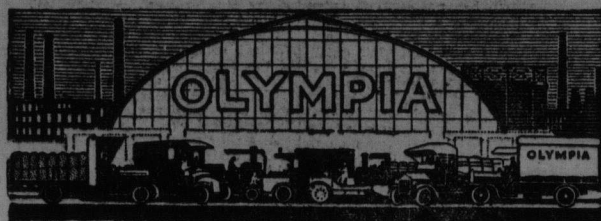

AGRICULTURE NEW PLAN IN EGG MARKETING IS WORKING OUT WELL

Co-operative Egg Circles, Established Under the Auspices of the Live Stock Branch of the Department of Agriculture are Proving their Value.

An important part of the poultry work of the Live Stock Branch of the Department of Agriculture, during the past year has been the organization of Co-operative Egg Circles. Ten circles in all have been organized under the auspices of the Branch, working in conjunction with the provincial and agricultural college authorities and the Poultry Producers' Association of Canada. The preliminary work in connection with a number of others has been done, and from present indications it is apparent that this phase of co-operative work is likely to have rapid growth in the near future.

Being primarily concerned with the improvement of the Canadian egg trade, the Live Stock Branch has encouraged the formation of these circles because the movement affords a means whereby the quality of eggs can be improved as they leave the farm, and the pernicious practice of holding eggs before the market and in the country stores largely eliminated. Co-operative effort of this kind also affords a medium whereby the eggs in any given community, may be collected and marketed frequently and regularly, and insures to the consumer a new-laid egg of uniform quality at no great increase in cost.

At the time of joining the association the members agree to stamp each egg with a given number designated by the Board of Directors. This is done so that the eggs of each member may be identified when graded and payment made, according to quality. A manager is appointed by the Board of Directors whose business it is to collect, grade, sell the eggs and apportion the returns among the members according to the quantity and quality received. In most circles the eggs from each farm, are collected at stated intervals, but in others the members deliver the eggs to some central point, such as a creamery, cheese factory, store or house, from which the manager makes the shipment.

It is well known that at certain seasons of the year, there is a wide difference between the price received for eggs by the farmer in the country store and the price by the consumer in the city. This difference is not nearly so marked in the spring of the year, as it is in the late summer, fall and winter. In other words, as the quality of ordinary farm eggs becomes more uncertain, the premium placed

on new-laid eggs of uniform quality, at no great increase in cost. While during the spring of the year prices received by circle members may not greatly exceed those paid in the local store, it is a fact that for the eggs produced in the month of December, last year, the majority of circles in the provinces of Ontario and Quebec, received a price of from 45 to 50 cents a dozen.

A limited number of circles will no doubt be able to take advantage of the rapidly growing select trade in the larger Canadian cities, but from the fact that the wholesale egg dealers in Ontario and Quebec have recently adopted a new system of buying on a basis of quality, it is likely that the product of the majority of circles will find its way to the consumer through the more recently established channels of trade.

The Live Stock Branch stands ready and willing to help on the egg circle movement, in every possible way. Officers of this Branch, are now in the field and there is available a quantity of literature, including outlines of constitutions, by-laws, etc., dealing with the work, copies of which may be obtained upon request from the Live Stock Commissioner, Ottawa.

DISTRIBUTION OF PURE BRED MALE ANIMALS BY DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, OTTAWA.

Realizing that inability to secure the use of well-bred male animals is at the present time one of the greatest difficulties standing in the way of live stock development in many parts of Canada, particularly in the newly settled districts, the Dominion Department of Agriculture, through the Live Stock Branch, is this year undertaking a widespread distribution of pure bred stallions, bulls, rams and boars. The original cost of the animals will be borne by the Department and they will be placed in the hands of such local organizations as agree to the conditions governing the distribution. In a word these sires will remain the property of the department, but the local associations will be responsible for their proper maintenance and management under the general supervision of the Live Stock Branch.

COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE EXHIBITION AT OLYMPIA, LONDON, JULY, 1913.

The future has arrived, so to speak, in the motor car industry. Its history differs curiously from that of the railway. The steam locomotive was applied to industrial work from its very imperfect beginnings. The motor car commenced as a very uncertain luxury, and has only lately discovered its complete usefulness. The application of the motor car to the movement of natural produce and manufactured goods in bulk, to traders' retail deliveries, to mail wagons, fire engines, and the whole mechanism of distribution and outdoor transit, means a thorough-going revolution in many ways.

The world at large is waking up to the vast possibilities of motor traction, and there is no industry that is not vitally affected. The International Exhibition to be held at Olympia, London, during July of this year comes just at the blossoming time of this great new industry, which will be just as important to the world's welfare and advancement as the establishment of railways in the last century. It is certain that the next generation will see vaster and more rapid commercial developments than the last.

The purpose of the Exhibition is to bring together the many types of vehicle now constructed under the heading of Commercial Motors. It will be one of the most significant Exhibitions ever held at Olympia. It will comprise Motor Lorries, Vans, Charabancs, Omnibuses, Taxicabs, Agricultural Motors and Tractors, Motor Fire Engines, Ambulances, Dust and Water Carts—in fact, every conceivable variety of motor vehicle for light and heavy haulage, and for every commercial, municipal, and agricultural purpose.

Nut Souffle.

This makes a dainty, delicious dessert. Whites of 3 eggs, 6 tablespoons sugar, 1-2 teaspoon almond extract or any desired flavoring, 1-4 cup chopped nuts.

Beat the whites until stiff, add the sugar gradually. Then stir in the nuts and flavoring, turn into a buttered dish and cook twenty minutes.

This could be cooked in the chafing dish, but it may be cooked in any double boiler. If a allowed to boil vigorously and the cover must not be raised during cooking, whether it is cooked in the chafing dish or in the double boiler. This dessert may be served in small glasses with jelly sauce and whipped cream. Simply melt a glass of currant jelly over hot water, put some of the melted jelly in each dish, then the souffle and last of all a spoonful of whipped cream topped by a maraschino cherry.

Nut Cookies.
Two tablespoons butter, 1-4 teaspoon sugar, 1 egg, 1 teaspoon baking powder, 1-4 teaspoon salt, 1-2 cup flour, 1 tablespoon milk, 1-2 cup finely chopped nuts, 1-2 teaspoon lemon juice.

Cream the butter, add sugar and egg well beaten. Mix and sift the dry ingredients, add them to the first mixture, then add the milk and, last, the lemon juice and walnuts. Drop from a spoon on an ungreased baking pan one inch apart. Place one half nut meat on the top of each and bake twenty to fifteen minutes in a slow oven. This makes twenty-four cookies. The nuts should be measured before they are chopped.
