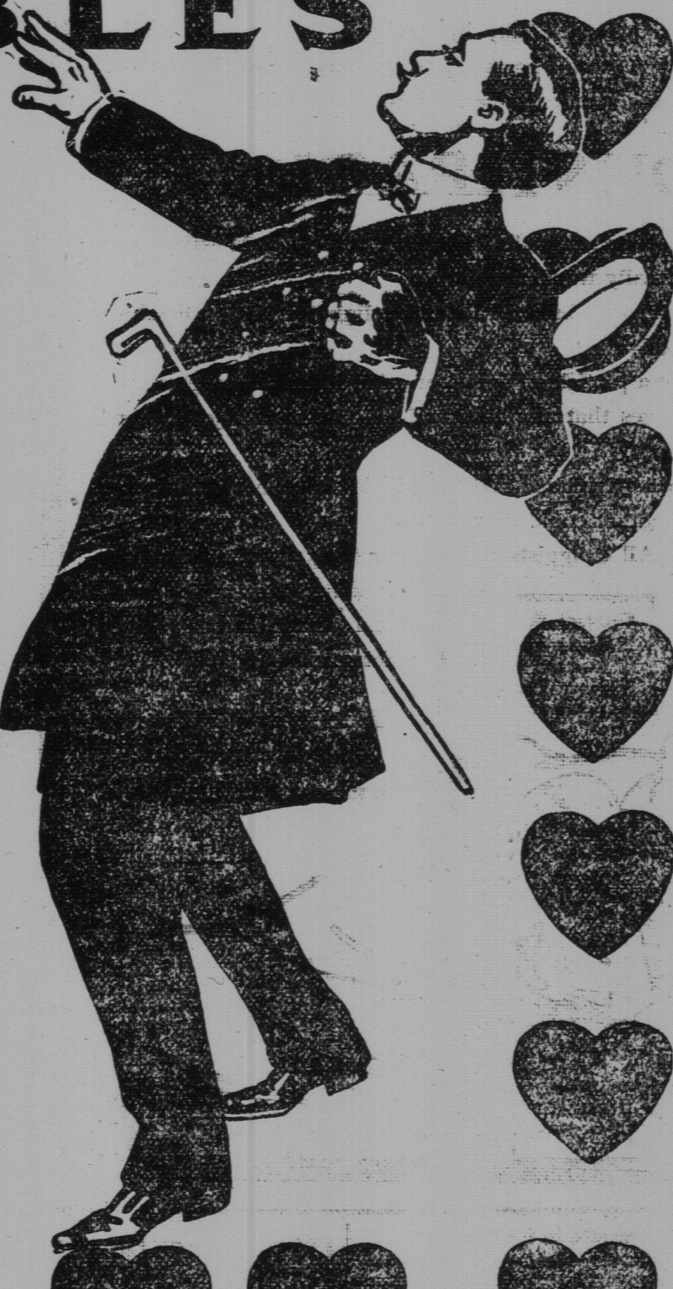

MORE PEOPLE HEARD

New Testimony Concerning the Public Hospital.

MORGUE DESCRIPTION.

Several People Who Were Recently There Say The Telegraph Has Properly Shown What The Place Is--Story of a Patient Who Recently Left the Hospital.

The Telegraph reporter who explored the hospital morgue Friday night and whose story was reprinted in an evening paper to be "a marvellous" has taken the pains to have the place which he visited identified by undertakers as the genuine and only morgue of the hospital. This was the place where Mr. Richards, the last man who died in the institution, was laid out and from which the undertaker buried him. An undertaker said he had officiated at several funerals from the hospital and in every case had laid out and taken the body either from the room in which death occurred or from the morgue which the Telegraph reporter visited Friday night.

Mrs. Wm. A. Muller, who was for some time employed as a laundress in the hospital, said the morgue when she was in the hospital was as described by The Telegraph. To the statement that the morgue was situated "at the front of the building," "quite near the elevator shaft," Mrs. Muller gave emphatic denial and said the morgue was at the "back of the building, the first door from the end and could be entered from the grounds."

As the persons mentioned were quite willing that their statements should be used in any way and as The Telegraph reporter did not see the morgue as described by the undertaker, Mrs. Percy and Mrs. Muller it would seem that in spite of the zealous efforts put forth by the evening paper previously mentioned, the reporter did "after all gratify his 'idle curiosity'."

The milk was good, but had evidently been skimmed. The meat was bad and the bread was often quite sour. The nurses used all the patients courteously as far as he saw. Some of the patients in beds near his were of foreign nationality, and could not understand English. Nurses had a hard time communicating with them and often got a patient to help them. Mr. McQuarty was in the top ward of the hospital.
