An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Port Burwell Harbour Company.

THEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act passed in the twelfth Preamble. year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to incorporate certain persons under the style and title of the President, Directors and Company of the Port Burwell Harbour," and also to amend an Act passed in 5 the Session held in the fourteenth and fifteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled " An Act to amend the Acts incorporating the Port Burwell Harbour Company," and to extend the powers of the said Company, to impose and levy toll on certain articles of lumber and merchandize: Be it therefore enacted, &c., as follows:

10 From and after the passing of this Act, it shall and may be lawful for the Company ausaid President, Directors and Company of the Port Burwell Harbour, to thorized to demand impose, demand, receive, take, levy and collect, with the like powers as rates. are in the said Acts provided for the recovery of rates or tolls on the following articles passing out of or through the said Harbour, not exceeding 15 the rates hereinafter mentioned, and from time to time to reduce, alter or amend the same, viz:

On every Standard Saw Log threepence. On Square and Round Timber, per 100 cubic feet, ninepence.

On every Spar or Mast seven shillings and sixpence.
