BILL.

An Act to repeal certain Acts therein mentioned, and to make better provision respecting the admission of Land Surveyors and the Survey of Lands in this Province.

WHEREAS the Laws now in force in Preamble. this Province respecting Land Surveyors and the Survey and Admeasurement of Lands are in many cases, owing to the 5 changes which have taken place in the method of surveying lands, found to be inapplicable: And whereas it is expedient to consolidate and amend them, Be it therefore enacted, &c.
