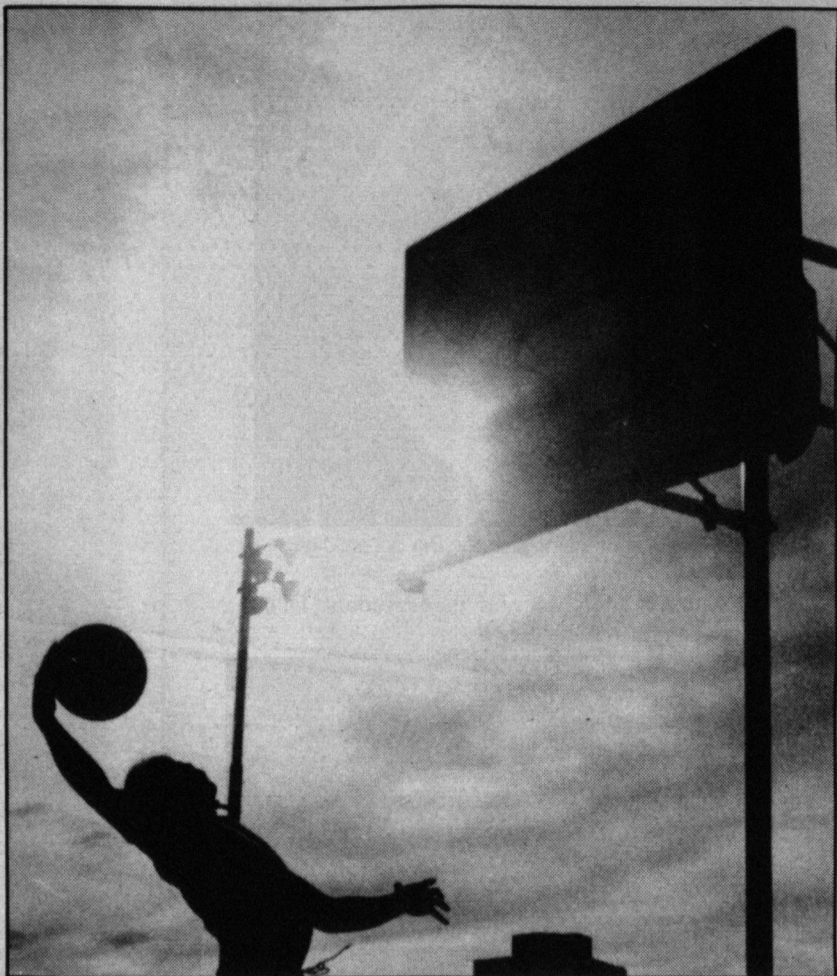


# Abstract Afternoon

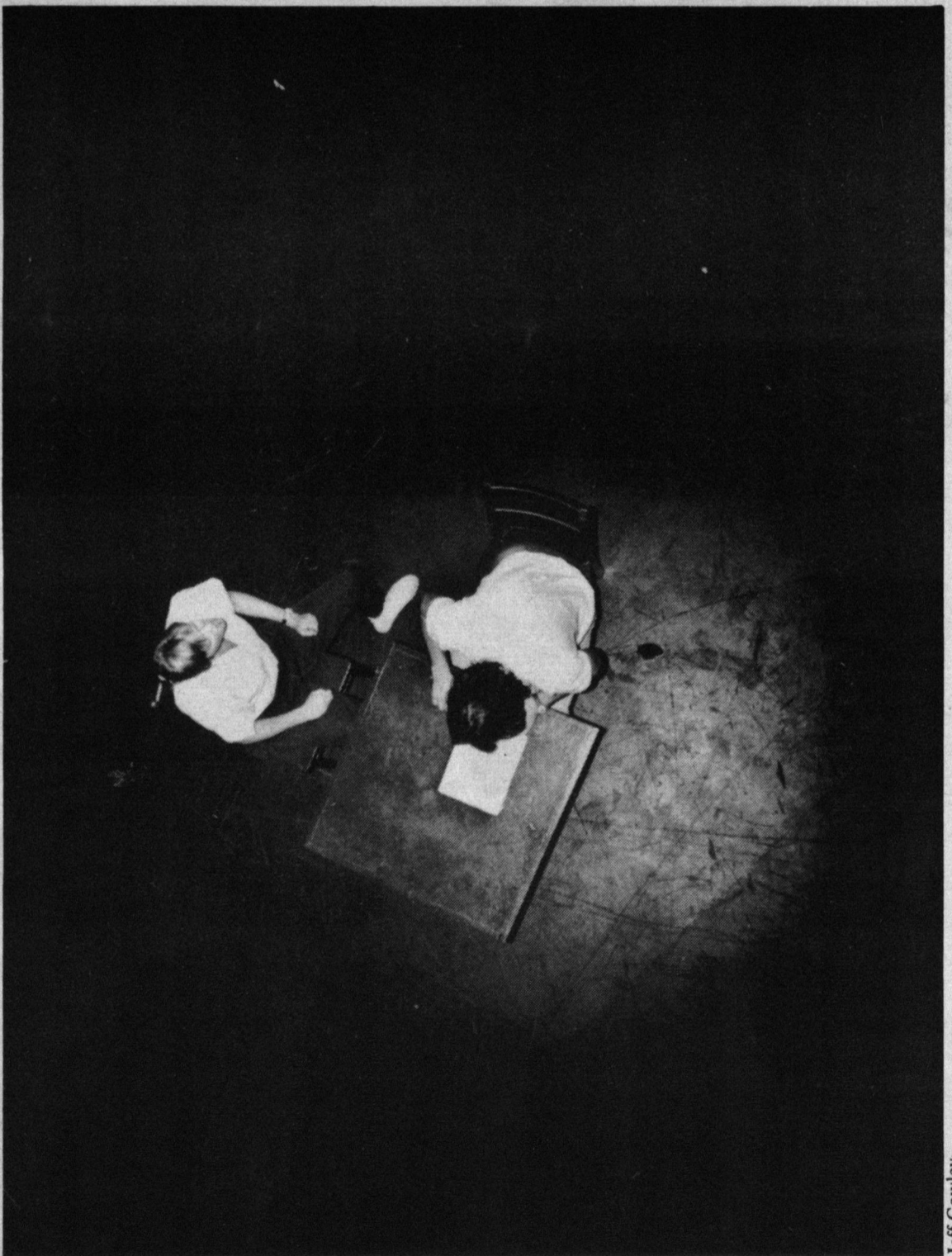

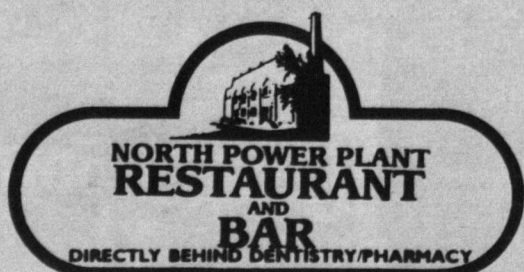
