	23-3-44		All flying washed out. At 1000 hours A D.C.M. assembled with S/L A.E. Mix of No. 1 T.C.H.Q. presiding. The Court assembled for the purpose of trying R112656 LAC Coburn, R.E. on a charge of being absent without leave.	
	24-3-44		At 1915 hours a picture was shown in the Station Theatre. 0800 hours ceiling 1 mile, visibility 4 miles. Flying washed in at 0830 hours. Washed out 1800 hours. Flying time 397.05 hours. No night flying. Edenvale: Flying washed in 0800 hours, washed out 1800 hours. Flying time 84.00 hours. At 1000 hours a G.C.M. was conducted at this Unit for the purpose of trying Flying Officer C.P. McEvoy on charges of breach of flying regulations. G/C H.G. Richards, C959, of No. 5 S.F.T.S. Brantford, was the President. At approximately 1040 hours Harvard II 2587 force landed in rough field. Upon recovery to level flight after let down the pilot noticed RPM 1300 no oil pressure and made a forced landing near Gookstown, Ontario. Neither the instructor, J29148 P/O E. Tremblay, nor the student, AUS436494 LAC Power, L.R., were injured. Categorized G. At 1915 hours a picture was shown in the Station Theatre.
