Sir,

I have the honor to inform you that a letter has been received from Mr Arthur Peake of Wianapore complaining of the manner in which he is treated by Sarsce Indians living upon the Reserve near his homestead in Tp. 22 Range 2 Sec. 34. Mr Peake complains that during his absences from home, the Indians have broken into his house and taken things away which cannot be replaced. That they frequently cut his stock loose from the pickets, and on one occasion they cut his harness nearly all to pieces.

He further states that he has always treated them well, fed them &c.

Kindly report on this and endeavour to restrain the Indians from committing the trespasses complained of.
