Mr. Maroney states that the apples and plums grown have a woody tasts, but that he considers that if the Indians were given advice by you, they might be able to do something to improve the quality of the cancellation diales fruit. I may say that the Department would be pleased to have you make arrengements, if possible, to visit the reserve in question at an early date in order to give instruction to the Indians. Mr. Maroney has stated that it is desirable that the notification of your visit be sent to the reserve two weeks ahead .
