Whereas by certain Letters Patent under the Great Seal bearing Preamble date at Westminster the Twenty-third day of March, 1931, His Letters late Majesty King George the Fifth did constitute, order, and declare Patent of that there should be a Governor General and Commander-in-Chief 23rd March, in and over Canada, and that the person filling the office of Governor. in and over Canada, and that the person filling the office of Governor General and Commander-in-Chief should be from time to time appointed by Commission under the Royal Sign Manual and Signet:

AND WHEREAS at St. James's on the Twenty-third day of March, 1931, His late Majesty King George the Fifth did cause certain Instructions under the Royal Sign Manual and Signet to be given to the Governor General and Commander-in-Chief:

AND WHEREAS it is Our Will and pleasure to revoke the Letters Patent and Instructions and to substitute other provisions in place thereof:

Now Therefore We do by these presents revoke and determine Revokes the said Letters Patent, and everything therein contained, and all Letters amendments thereto, and the said Instructions, but without prejudice 23rd March, to anything lawfully done thereunder:

AND WE do declare Our Will and pleasure as follows:

I. We do hereby constitute, order, and declare that there shall Office of be a Governor General and Commander-in-Chief in and over Canada, Governor and appointments to the Office of Governor General and Commander-in-Chief in and over Canada shall be made by Commission under in-Chief constituted. Our Great Seal of Canada.

II. And We do hereby authorize and empower our Governor His powers General, with the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada or of any and members thereof or individually, as the case requires, to exercise authorities. all powers and authorities lawfully belonging to Us in respect of Canada, and for greater certainty but not so as to restrict the generality of the foregoing to do and execute, in the manner aforesaid, all things that may belong to his office and to the trust We have reposed in him according to the several powers and authorities granted or appointed him by virtue of The British North America granted or appointed him by virtue of The British North America enid ni baseov ace vested in him.
