AIR OPERATIONS

BERLIN WAS bombed during the night.
Other enemy targets were also attacked by Allied
planes.

EASTERN FRONT

Two powerful Soviet armies have almost encircled
BUDAPEST.
BERLIN Broadcasts that the Hungarian Government has
fled to the Austrian Frontier town of SOPRON.
No change reported in other sectors.

FRANCE - RUSSIA

MOSCOW has announced the signing of a Treaty of
Alliance and mutual assistance with FRANCE.
Complete unanimity of views have been reached
between the two Nations.

GREECE

A General of the National Liberation Front Militia
whose conflict with the Regular Greek Govt and British
troops, is reported to have surrendered.
The name of the General has not been announced.
In SALONIKA, the Socialist Bloc has refrained from
signing a resolution calling for a General Strike in
the City.

ITALIAN FRONT

Savage German counter-attacks have failed to halt
the Allied drive to capture FAENZA.
The Nazis hurled their weight against the EIGHTH
Army newly-won bridgehead over the LAMONE yesterday
but all attacks were beaten off.

WESTERN FRONT

Strong counter-attacks against American THIRD Army
positions along the SAAR River are reported this morning.
All these counter-attacks were repulsed.
In the SOUTH, the SEVENTH Army is attacking in the
area of HAGUENAU in NORTHERN ALSACE.
Farther SOUTH, the FRENCH FIRST Army is closing on
COLMAR.
Snow has blanketed the NORTHERN Front.
