14. In conclusion I emphasized that if, as I feared, the new regulations seriously diminished Canadian income from tourist traffic, this would have a grave effect on Canada's war effort. I said that after I had reported to you on this matter, you would no doubt be instructing me to submit formal representations to the United States authorities.

15. Following our conversations with Mr. Long, Mr. Reid had further conversations with Mr. Warren, the Chief of the Visa Division of the Department of State, and with Mr. Shaughnessy, Deputy Commissioner of Immigration and Naturalization. These discussions will be reported on in the immediately following despatch.
