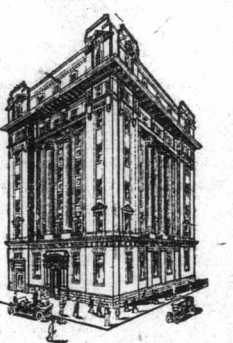

BATTERY ORDERS

Col. Ashton and Men Will Go to Petawawa on Saturday.

The Battery will parade at the Battery quarters in marching order with haversacks on Saturday, June 6th, at 12.30 a.m., and proceed via T. H. & B. Railway to Petawawa for annual training.

Each man will provide himself with tin plate, tin cup, knife, fork and spoon, and one day's ration, to be carried in the haversack. Extra pair boots, socks, underwear, shirt, comb, or brush, shaving material, soap, towels, clothes brush, boot cleaning equipment, button stick, all to be carried in kit bag.

Mounted men will also furnish curry comb and brush in kit bag. All kit bags must be plainly ticketed with Battery number and name, and be in the battery quarters not later than 9 a.m. Saturday morning.

In accordance with militia orders no intoxicating liquors will be permitted on the train or in camp.
