The other ships include in addition to several trawlers four neutral ships, two Danish, one

Norwegian and one Swedish. which is some distance northeast of Przemysl. Notwithstanding the evacuation of this fortress, the Russians 0 00 have maintained an unbroken fighting front on both sides of the railroad to Lemberg. Thus far the Austrians and Germans apparently have made little progress since the taking of Przemysl although an official report states that the Russians have been driven east

Price Duties-Six months residence in each of hree years after earning homestead pat-nt; also 50 acres extra cultivation. Pre-mption patent may be obtained as soon as omestead patent, on certain conditions. A settler who has exhausted his home-

The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions. W. W. CORY, C.M.G.,

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-

over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominiou land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency), on certain conditions. Dutier—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of it least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

A settler who has exhausted his home-stead right may take a purchased home-stead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate 50 acres and erect a house werth \$300.
