London, Dec. 7. - Jules Polo of Nantes, France, has written an article upon the South African war in which he strongly condemns the British Government. Strangely enough, the article is translated into English and printed in London, whence it is distributed by Boer sympathizers and by Englishmen who are not in accord with their government in the subjugation of the Dutch Republic.
