Washixors, D. C., July 16.—The net gold in the treasury increased from \$158, 933,005, July 1, 1885, to \$186,875,669, July 1, 1887. Since July 1, the gold holdings have decreased \$5,5602, 122, while the circulation of gold certificates has increased \$5,263, 770. The circulation of standard silver dollars has increased \$78,8016 since the lat. The total amount of bonds redeemed under the call which matured on the lat inst. is \$18,909,250, leaving still outstanding of that call \$1,626,656. The total amount of called bonds outstanding is \$5,300,450.

The government receipts so far this month amount to \$10,693,567, and the expenditures (including nearly \$12,000,000 pension payments) to \$18,561,102, making an excess of expenditures of \$7,867,535. It is estimated that the receipts during the remainder of the month will average \$1,000,000 a day, and that the expenditures will be correspondingly large.
