GREEK CEREMONIAL ST. PAUL'S CATHEDRAL

Funeral of Nicholas Hrisikos Conducted Under Custom of Orthodox Greek Church.

Nicholas Hrisikos, former proprietor of the London Cafe, and one of the most popular residents of London, was buried in Woodland Cemetery yesterday. Funeral rites of the Greek Orthodox Church, were celebrated in St. Paul's Anglican Cathedral the first time in the history of London. Rev. Father Daniel Skarpas of Toronto, a priest of the Greek Orthodox Church, officiated.

As the members of the Greek colony of London have no church here, Very Rev. Dean L. Norman, who granted permission to the nephew of the late Mr. Hrisikos, Harry and Gus Lukos of Windsor, to have the services conducted at the cathedral, stated that the Church of England and the Greek Orthodox Church recognize each other and co-operate in various cities, Church of England members attending Greek churches and Greek church members attending Anglican churches. Peter Paris of Toronto assisted Father Skarpas by singing the prayers at the cathedral.

The funeral was one of the largest ever held in London, and was attended by a large number of Greeks from all parts of Western Ontario. In paying his last tribute to the deceased, Father Skarpas stated the late Mr. Hrisikos was a man of high character and a worthy citizen of Canada and won the respect of the native population.

Before the casket was lowered into the grave Father Skarpas followed the old Greek custom of covering the face of the deceased with silk and then placing earth with oil on the silk. As he performed this rite he made the customary declaration that people of the earth are made from earth and created in the image of God. The pallbearers were Gus Lukos
