

A QUESTION OF MILLIONS.

THE DEEPENING OF THE CANALS.

An interesting discussion in the House of Commons on Col. Fred. Denison's Motion to Deepen the Soulanges Canal.

Mr. Haggart Opposes the Scheme as Impracticable and Too Costly.

OTTAWA, March 14.—It was fully expected that Hon. John G. Diefenbaker would introduce a bill to deepen the Soulanges Canal, but he was not on hand to see the little drama which would be enacted when the Minister of Agriculture is present.

At the last moment he decided that he would wait until to-morrow, when Secretary of State Patterson was expected to be in the Capital, and the two presentations would take place on the same day.

It is asserted, however, that Mr. Patterson will not be here to-morrow, so that the Conservatives cannot celebrate their dual triumph should the bill be introduced and daily applauded.

The central incident of the day was Col. Denison's speech on his motion favoring increasing the depth of the Soulanges Canal to 20 feet and the debate that followed on it, in which the new Minister of Railways and Canals took part.

Col. Denison had come well prepared with facts to support his contention that the canal and channels between Montreal and Port Arthur should be increased to a depth of 18 feet, which would be able to pass between two points without transferring cargo, and that the bulk in any way.

He said the whole history of our canal was that construction was scarcely finished before it was found that a greater depth was required. He took up the history of each canal and showed that it was not enough to go to the bottom of the canal and dredge it, but that the whole of the canal had to be deepened.
