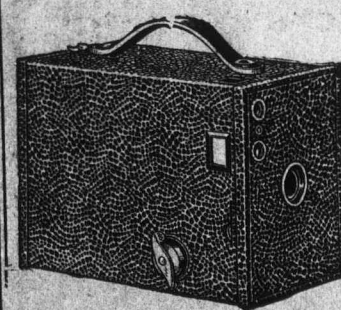

The entire business of the garage was threatened when a fire completely destroyed the large garage owned by J. C. Captown. Smoke was pouring from every crevice in the building when first discovered by C. W. Browne, at 5.40 a.m. The garage, an immense two-storey wooden structure, built in 1878, was a ready victim to the huge flame which soon enveloped it. Neighboring business houses and nearby homes were only saved by the work of the village fire brigade, and the aid of volunteer citizens.

It is the Highway Traffic Act, a provincial statute, that is not a municipal bylaw, which requires that all commercial motor vehicles be equipped with mirrors. This was brought to the attention of a market gardener, who was charged in the London court with failure to equip his truck. "Many truck owners have the idea that this is a municipal regulation, applying only to cities," observed the magistrate. "They think that mirrors are not required by law in the country. That is a wrong impression."
