The Canadian Northern Ry. put the standard train rules in force on its lines May 17.

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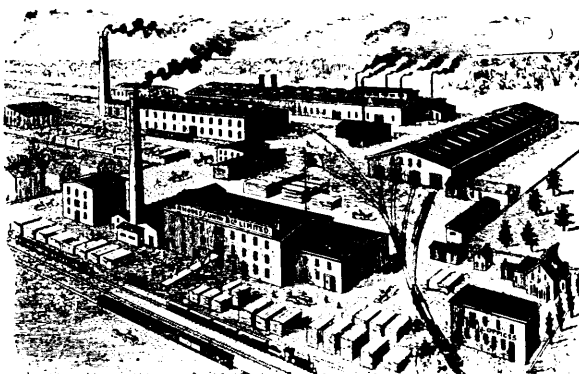
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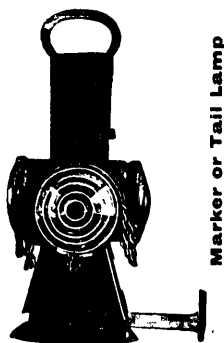
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
