No. 27-GREEN BELT AS PROPOSED BY OTTAWA PLANNING AREA BOARD 1947

In 1947 the Ottawa Planning Area Board, which comprised all the urban municipalities, decided that unified control of municipal services was essential for the urban area. As a result of this report, the Gore and Storrie Plan for the extension of municipal sewer and water services was prepared. The OPAB recognized at this time the desirability of a Green Belt to control the ultimate built-up area and recommended the boundaries shown on the chart. The belt shown is too narrow to effectively achieve the desired results.
