## INQUIRY

By the Honourable Senator Cameron:

22nd November—That he will inquire of the Government:—

1. How many students of university grade are presently studying in Canada under The Colombo Plan?
2. How many students have been enrolled in Canada under this Plan since its inception?
3. How are these classified as between those studying for bachelors' degrees, masters' degrees and doctorates?
4. How many students of university grade are enrolled in Canadian universities under the Commonwealth Scholarship Program? From what countries do they come? How are they classified as in 3 above?
5. Are any students from outside the Commonwealth in Canada under the extension of this plan as of this date? If so, from what countries do they come?
6. What provisions, if any, have been taken by members of NATO to coordinate their plans for training:
  - (a) technical personnel to serve in under-developed countries,
  - (b) train native technical personnel in NATO countries?
7. Can the Government give an estimate of the total numbers of such personnel being trained in all NATO countries?  
Can this information be given country by country?
