It is possible this Republic was founded in error. It is possible that the Declaration of Independence was a mistake and the Constitution a blunder.

But you and I hold to the faith of the fathers.

You and I still cling to the great and original principles of free government which are the everlasting glory of the English-speaking peoples.

Long live the Republic!
